

TEST of the CodeRED Community Notification System

The Township of Nipigon Emergency Notification System, CodeRED, will be tested on Thursday, February 10, 2022 to validate telephone numbers in the Township's database.

Here's what you need to know:

- If you receive a call from (866)419-5000, this is the CodeRED Emergency Call and No Action is required. Emergency personnel are merely testing the system to ensure it is operational as needed, and to encourage additional residents to enroll to receive future notifications.
- This process helps us continually improve the system. Testing increases the efficiency of the system and speed at which notifications will be delivered during an actual emergency.
- Visit our website at https://www.nipigon.net/codered to add or update your contact information. If your contact information is not in the database, you will not receive a call when we do launch an important notification. The more residents who actively add or update their contact information in the emergency database, the better able we are to protect people and property.

The CodeRED system allows the Township officials to effectively reach residents and personnel by using the system's capabilities to send telephone calls, text messages, emails and social media posts to inform residents and better protect life and property.
